

Why Social Entrepreneurship & SSO


- For-Profit Functioning as A Non-Profit

Case #1 Little Earth of United Tribes

- American Indian Preference Public Housing Project of 900 people
- Between Homeless and Section 8
- Highest Obesity, Diabetes, Lead Poisoning Rates in Minnesota

Poverty, Gangs, Violence, Race, Food Desert
56% under 19 and 80% women & children
5 people per unit and under \$8,685/unit/year
Most environmentally dirty neighborhood

 Case Study #2 The Maldives
 2000 islands, > 1 million people, fragile Democracy

- Highest elevation 7', First nation to disappear from global warming by 2050, dozen islands already lost
- Import 98% of all food—true food desert
- Fish being vacuumed by Japanese companies
- All water aquifers polluted
- Ocean dumping of biosolids & Solid Waste
- Life expectancy of 60 because of Sanitation

2011 Program

- Begin Composting of Biosolids and SSO
- Replace all septic tanks & use septic pumpers
- End ocean dumping and pollution of aquifer
- Construct greenhouses and digesters to begin food production and waste treatment
- Goal of providing cooking gas from biogas and 5% of electricity
- Massively begin food production of veggies
