

LOCAL LAW 42

REPORT ORDERED BY NYC COUNCIL TO BE COMPLETED BY JULY 2012. TO BE ISSUED BY THE NYC DEPARTMENT OF SANITATION & O.L.T.P.S.

- STUDY THE VIABILITY OF "CURBSIDE COMPOSTING"
- IDENTIFY COMPOSTING FACILITIES WITHIN 300 MILES OF NYC
- ASSESS CAPACITY OF TRANSFER STATIONS WITHIN 60 MILES OF NYC
- EXPLORE OPPORTUNITIES TO COMPOST WITHIN NYC, OR; EXPLORE OPPORUNITIES TO DEVELOP A FACILITY WITHIN 60 MILES
- IDENTIFY CURRENT SITES IN NYC ACCEPTING ORGANICS REFUSE
- PROVIDE A PLAN TO STUDY THE VIABILITY FOR COMPOSTING RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL WASTE STREAMS (TO BE ISSUED WITHIN TWO YEARS OF THE REPORT)


