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


AISD Waste Characterization


Front of House (Post-Consumer)

■ Recyclables ■ Trash ■ Compostables












Pilot Program- AISD 2010

- 4 elementary schools
- •4 months
- •Implemented Single Stream Recycle and composting
- •Trained and educated students, faculty, and staff
- Diverted over 50,000 lbs of food waste

■ Compost/ Recycle ■ Trash









- January 2011- Awarded 5 year contract with AISD for recycle, compost and trash
- •122 locations- Single Stream Recycling
- •81 locations- Composting
- Started







Materials collected each month this semester, listed in pounds and converted to pounds per student based on first month enrollment.





- Product stewardship






